The route serves: Bishop Sutton, Chew Stoke, Chew Magna, Pensford, Clutton, Temple Cloud, Farrington Gurney, Paulton, Tesco at Old Mills, Welton, Midsomer Norton, Radstock Road, Radstock and Westfield.

- The maximum single adult fare on service 101 is £2, with a hop between neighbouring villages being £1.50.
- AvonRider day and week tickets are both available and accepted on service 101.
- Child fares are £1 for any single journey. We also offer Kids Go Free during school holidays.
